

North Tour Hanimaadhoo to Male 11 nights

Departure: Hanimaadhoo, check in 4pm

Return: Male Check out 7am

The North tour promises an exceptional diving experience.

The far north, once home to the Amba, offers an almost untouched diving area with beautiful corals and unparalleled tranquility.

The itinerary includes approximately 30 dives in total over the 12-day, 11-night trip, suitable for Advanced Open Water divers with a minimum of 50 logged dives.

The best of the north features a unique diving holiday with limited trips to ensure an individual and memorable experience.

Day 1: Arrival

Guests are required to make their way to the domestic flight check-in according to their flight tickets for a flight to Hanimaadhoo.

Upon arrival, a staff member will greet the guests at the domestic airport.

A short transfer will take them to the Amba, where a welcome drink and a refreshing cold lime towel await.

The tour guide will provide a brief orientation of the ship and the day's activities before guiding the guests to their cabins to freshen up.

Depending on the arrival time, equipment setup will either occur before or after dinner.

Dinner will be served around 6 p.m., followed by crew introductions and a general safety briefing.

The rest of the evening is for getting acquainted with fellow liveaboard guests.

Day 2 to Day 11: Diving Days

From the second day until two days before disembarkation, 2-3 (usually 3) dives are offered daily from the diving support vessel (Dhoani), including one-night dive per week. T

he dive sites are carefully selected, with detailed briefings in English to prepare divers. On days when the vessel is crossing, only 1-2 dives can be scheduled.

Penultimate Day: Last Dive

The last dive takes place at 8 a.m. After this final dive, guests can wash and dry their equipment onboard the Dhoani.

The liveaboard and the support vessel will reach Male harbor by 5 p.m. at the latest.

Day 12: Departure

Check-out from Amba is in the morning at 6:45 a.m. or 9:30 a.m.

The transfer vessel takes approximately 30 minutes to the airport, allowing guests to catch flights departing from 9 a.m. onwards. Late check-out is not available.
