

Best of North Tour - Male to Hanimaadhoo 11 nights

Departure: Male check in at 4pm

Return: Hanimaadhoo check out 7am

Approx 30 dives

Experience level: Advanced Open water and 50 logged dives

During this 11-night "Best of North" tour, Amba, a pioneer in the region for nearly 20 years, will start in Male and visit various atolls: Male, Lhaviyani, Baa (Hanifaru Bay), Noonu, Shaviyani, Haa Dhaalu, and Haa Alif.

The far north, home to Amba for many years, offers an almost untouched diving area with beautiful corals and unparalleled tranquility.

Encounters with other diving ships will be rare, ensuring a unique and individual diving holiday.

Day 1: Arrival

Guests will be greeted at Male Airport around the Burger King Restaurant.

After a short transfer to the Amba, they will receive a welcome drink and a refreshing cold lime towel.

The tour guide will give a brief orientation about the ship and the day's schedule before guiding guests to their cabins to freshen up.

Depending on the arrival time, equipment setup will occur either before or after dinner.

Dinner will be served around 6 p.m., followed by crew introductions and a general safety briefing.

The rest of the evening will be spent getting to know the other liveaboard guests.

Days 2-11: Diving Days

From the second day until two days before disembarking, 2-3 (usually 3) dives will be offered daily from the diving support vessel (Dhoani), including one-night dive per week.

The dive sites, carefully selected, will be introduced with detailed briefings in English.

On days when the vessel is crossing, only 1-2 dives will be scheduled.

Penultimate Day: Last Dive

The last dive will take place at 8 a.m.

After the dive, guests can wash and dry their equipment onboard the Dhoani.

The liveaboard and support vessel will reach Hanimaadhoo harbor by 5 p.m. at the latest.

Day 12: Departure

Check-out from Amba will be in Hanimaadhoo at any time, with a transfer vessel taking about 10 minutes to the airport.

For guests with late flights, meals will be provided.

After breakfast and check-out, preparations for disembarkation will begin.

The crew will organize the transfer to the airport and assist with check-in for onward flights.

Divers are recommended to wait 24 hours before flying after their last dive.
