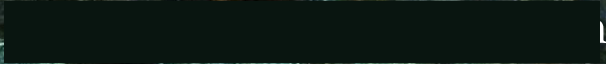

# Komodo National Park

The Komodo national park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is located east of Bali, an hour flight away, right close to the island of Flores.

It includes two main islands – Komodo proper and Rinca – and 27 smaller islands, spread over a marine area of some 1,750 square kilometers.

No trip to Komodo would be worth without a hike to see one or more of the famous “Komodo dragons”, the largest lizard of the animal kingdom. Their habitat is a mix of monsoon forest and open savannah, a habitat they share with buffalos, deers and a wide variety of birds.

The underwater world is at least as spectacular as the sceneries above water: this is one of the richest ecosystem on earth, being part of the coral triangle. Whether a diver or a snorkeler, no one can remain immune to the kaleidoscopic beauty of these tropical coral reefs. Throw in a few stops on idyllic beach and a visit to a welcoming village and you have a cruise you won't be close to forget.

Swimming with manta rays is one of the must-dos in Komodo, but there is no shortage of beautiful coral reefs and marine animals in Komodo either.

Situated in the Coral Triangle, the national park hosts over 1,000 species of tropical fish, 260 species of coral, and just a spectacular biodiversity overall.

Much of Komodo's underwater beauty can be observed from the surface without any scuba gear, making it an excellent snorkeling destination.

# BEYOND KOMODO

*We An excellent itinerary if you are visiting komodo for first time or wishes to see the best of the Komodo National Park*

Highlights: Swim with manta rays, snorkel or dive\* some of Coral Triangle's best spots, mingle with the locals, see Komodo dragons & discover the world famous Pink Beach and hike Padar for it's breathtaking views.



## *Day 1*

Upon arrival at Labuan Bajo airport we immediately transfer you to the harbor where the vessel is waiting. Once you are aboard our cruise director will first give you a general briefing to familiarize you with the vessel and our safety procedures. Then we cast off/raise the anchor and the vessel goes to **Sabolon** island for our first swim & snorkeling along a white sand beach.





## Day 2 / 3

During breakfast we sail to **Gili Lawa Laut** and **Gili Lawa Darat**. Those small islands located in the north of Komodo, offers beautiful landscapes and some of the prettiest snorkeling sites in the Park.

The channels between those islands are truly is a snorkelers paradise: the reef which has colorful hard and soft coral growth, abundant sponges and fish life provide homes for huge clouds of schooling anthias and fusiliers and even Manta Rays. In late afternoon our staff will take you to an amazing spot on the hill to enjoy the sunset over the Park.



## Day 4

we will spend our day exploring the crystal-clear waters off “**Karang Makasar**”, a superb reef surrounded by superb beaches where Manta ray and turtles can often be spotted. | It will be also a day of nature **exploration** on different snorkelling spots with our zodiac, and some relaxing time on remote beaches surrounded by crystal-clear waters. A perfect place for kayaking, paddle and an APERO on the beach. Night at anchor





## Day 5

Today we will go ashore to visit the traditional village of Komodo and we will take on a hike in the Island to spot the famous **Komodo Dragons**. After that we will anchor the BUGIS along a gorgeous **pink beach**. In the afternoon proceed to the island of **Padar** for climbing a hill late afternoon and enjoy incredible scenery at sunset on the surrounding islands of the park.



## Day 6

After breakfast and a last swim in paradise, we will arrive at the harbour of Labuan Bajo (west-coast of Flores). At 11, we say farewell to the crew and we will transfer you to the airport with a great memory to keep.
