Raja Ampat National Park

The Raja Ampat archipelago consists of some 600 Islands and islets that straddle the equator in the area off the "Birds Head". The name Raja Ampat literally means 'the Four Kings' and dates back to the time that the islands were ruled from the North Moluccan sultanates of Ternate. At that time the four larger islands in Waigeo, Salawati, Batanta and Misool used to have an independent king. Most of the islands have rugged and steep coastlines and are covered with virgin rainforest. The larger islands are lightly populated, but most others are still uninhabited by humans.

Raja Ampat is also famous as for his underwater world: marine biologists have concluded that this area is home to seventy percent of the known coral species on the planet. Many fish, corals and crustaceans that live in these waters are found nowhere else on earth. Welcome aboard for a real voyage of a lifetime.





Day 1

Upon arrival at Sorong airport we immediately transfer you to the harbour where BUGIS is waiting. Once you are aboard our cruise director will first give you a general briefing to familiarize you with the vessel and our safety procedures. Then we cast raise the anchor and sailing to YAP island, first island of the four kings for our fist snorkeling where lay beautiful pristine underwater and white sand beaches awaits us. After dinner, we'll sail towards our next destination, Waigeo.



Start your day with a refreshing swim at the beautiful Saonek Kecil beach, then dive into a snorkeling adventure at Mioskon Island, Waigeo. Afterward, enjoy a delicious lunch as we head towards the charming village of Yenbeser Island. There, you'll have the opportunity for more snorkeling along a stunning wall, followed by another relaxing swim at the beach.





Day 3

Today, we're beginning our day bright and early with a kayaking adventure along a tranquil lagoon river nestled in the jungle. Our goal? Spotting some vibrant tropical birds like parrots or hornbills, even the red bird of paradise if you an early riser. After that, we'll pay a visit to the village of Yenbeser. Following our lunch, we'll dive into the crystal-clear waters to snorkel at one of Raja Ampat's finest reefs, located at Cap Kri. We'll round off our day by fishing in the charming bay of Yenbuba.



In the early morning, we'll set sail from the bay to the picturesque small island of Arborek. Beneath the wooden pontoon and along the stunning beach, get ready to witness magnificent hard coral formations and an incredible variety of fish. We'll also take some time to explore the village ashore. The highlight of the day will be snorkeling at the Manta Ridge. In the afternoon, we'll drop anchor near the lovely island of Yeben, where we'll delight in another beautiful beach and more snorkeling adventures.





Day 5

Piaynemo is undoubtedly another marvel in Raja Ampat. Dive into the crystal-clear waters and behold the stunning reef set against lush forest scenery for yet another fantastic snorkeling experience. Explore the lagoon by kayak and wrap up your exploration with a rewarding hike to the hilltop, where breathtaking views await.

Day 6

Our last day in paradise will be filled with surprising snorkeling adventures at Sawandarek and Yanbuba jetties, two of the best spots in Raja Ampat. Expect to see lots of fish, turtles, and even reef sharks! We'll also take the time to visit the friendly local community in the village adjacent to the jetties. To top it off, we'll enjoy the sunset at the charming bay on the island of Mansuar, where we can leisurely kayak in the lagoon.





Day 7

Back in the harbor of Sorong on the mainland. After breakfast, we say farewell to the captain and crew and transfer you to the airport for the return flight to Bali or to any other destination.
