


## Overview

This unique expedition sails between Komodo National Park and Sumbawa Island, combining world-class dive sites with remote exploration and one truly unforgettable highlight: snorkeling or diving with whale sharks in Saleh Bay. With fewer boats and more wild nature, this itinerary is ideal for those seeking off-the-map marine adventures.





#### IDEAL FOR:

Divers and snorkelers who crave unique encounters, fewer crowds, and a real sense of exploration. Perfect for return guests or anyone looking to combine world-class diving with once-in-a-lifetime moments – like meeting a whale shark eye-to-eye.



### DIVING HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✓ Saleh Bay (Teluk Saleh) swim with resident whale sharks that gather around fishing platforms (bagans)
- ✓ Iconic Komodo sites like Batu Bolong, Castle Rock, and Manta Point
- ✓ Remote reefs of western Sumbawa healthy, untouched, and full of life

✔ Pinnacles, walls, and sloping reefs with reef

sharks, turtles, and schooling fish

✓ Incredible macro life: pygmy seahorses,

✓ Night dives with rare critters and glowing

nudibranchs, and ghost pipefish

### FOR SNORKELERS:

This route is very rewarding for adventurous snorkelers. Whale shark encounters in Saleh Bay are typically at the surface, making it a highlight even without scuba. Central Komodo and Sumbawa offer vibrant coral gardens and shallow reef edges full of life.
