DAY 01

LABUAN BAJO & PULAU KAABA

Arrival in Labuan Bajo in the afternoon and transfer to Jakare. Welcome drinks and safety briefing onboard before settling into cabins. If time permits, sail to Pulau Sebayur Kecil for a refresh dive, then continue to Pulau Kaaba/Rincafor bat watching at sunset.

Evening at anchor near Pulau Kaaba, enjoying the sundeck and stargazing.

Diver option:

- **SEBAYUR KECIL:** A gentle refresh dive to test equipment and reacclimate to diving.



DAY 02

PULAU RINCA, KOMODO DRAGONS & PULAU PADAR

Early morning sail to Pulau Kambing, followed by breakfast onboard. Visit Loh Buaya (Rinca Island) for a guided trek through the savannah to observe Komodo dragons, wild boars, and deer in their natural habitat.

Jakare then sails toward Pulau Tengah, followed by Pulau Mawan, offering pristine marine environments for underwater exploration. In the late afternoon, the journey continues to Pulau Padar, where guests will anchor for the night.

Diver Option:

- **WAINILU:** One of Komodo's best muck dives, located in the mangroves, rich in macro life.
- **PULAU TENGAH:** A pinnacle dive in Komodo's strong currents, featuring colorful coral walls, sharks, turtles, and large schools of fish.
- **PULAU MAWAN:** A shallow coral garden, home to manta rays, sharks, and turtles.





DAY 03

PULAU PADAR & CENTRAL-SOUTH KOMODO

Early morning trek to Padar's summit for a breathtaking sunrise over the Komodo archipelago. After breakfast, enjoy a refreshing swim before setting off for a series of spectacular dives.

Jakare will then sail to Pantai Merah (Pink Beach), one of Komodo's most iconic sites, where guests can relax on the unique pink sands, snorkel, or dive in the surrounding coral gardens. As the day ends, enjoy the sunset on the beach, followed by dinner onboard.

Diver Option:

- **THREE SISTERS:** A challenging dive with three large submerged rocks (3-30m), home to nudibranchs, fusiliers, coral fish, and pelagic species.
- **PILLARSTEEN:** A colorful wall dive with sponges, caves, swim-throughs, and large schools of fusiliers.
- **SECRET GARDEN:** A vibrant coral reef with abundant marine life, often visited by manta and mobula rays.
- **NIGHT DIVE (Optional)** – Pantai Merah: A thrilling night dive to observe Komodo's nocturnal marine creatures.



DAY 04

KOMODO CENTRAL

Early morning sail to Komodo Central, with breakfast served en route. Jakare will anchor near Pulau Siaba, where guests will take a dinghy to Karang Makassar, a renowned manta ray cleaning and feeding station.

After a break onboard, Jakare continues to Batu Bolong, one of Komodo's most iconic dive sites. The day's diving concludes at Pulau Tatawa, known for its vibrant coral and marine biodiversity.

In the afternoon, Jakare sails north toward Gili Lawa, where guests may spot wild boars or deer along the coastline.

Overnight anchorage in a peaceful bay at Gili Lawa.

DAY 05

PULAU GILI LAWA

The day begins with an exciting dive at Golden Passage, a current-filled channel between Gili Lawa and Komodo Island, rich in soft and hard corals, turtles, and hunting trevallies.

Jakare then sails north to Gili Lawa Laut, where guests will dive at Crystal Rock, a pinnacle known for clear waters, reef sharks, and giant trevallies. The third dive takes place at Castle Rock, one of Komodo's most famous sites, offering schools of jacks, reef sharks, snappers, and vibrant coral life.

In the late afternoon, Jakare sails south to a quiet bay on Gili Lawa's east coast, where guests can relax onboard, explore the island, or paddle along the reef with Kayak/SUP.

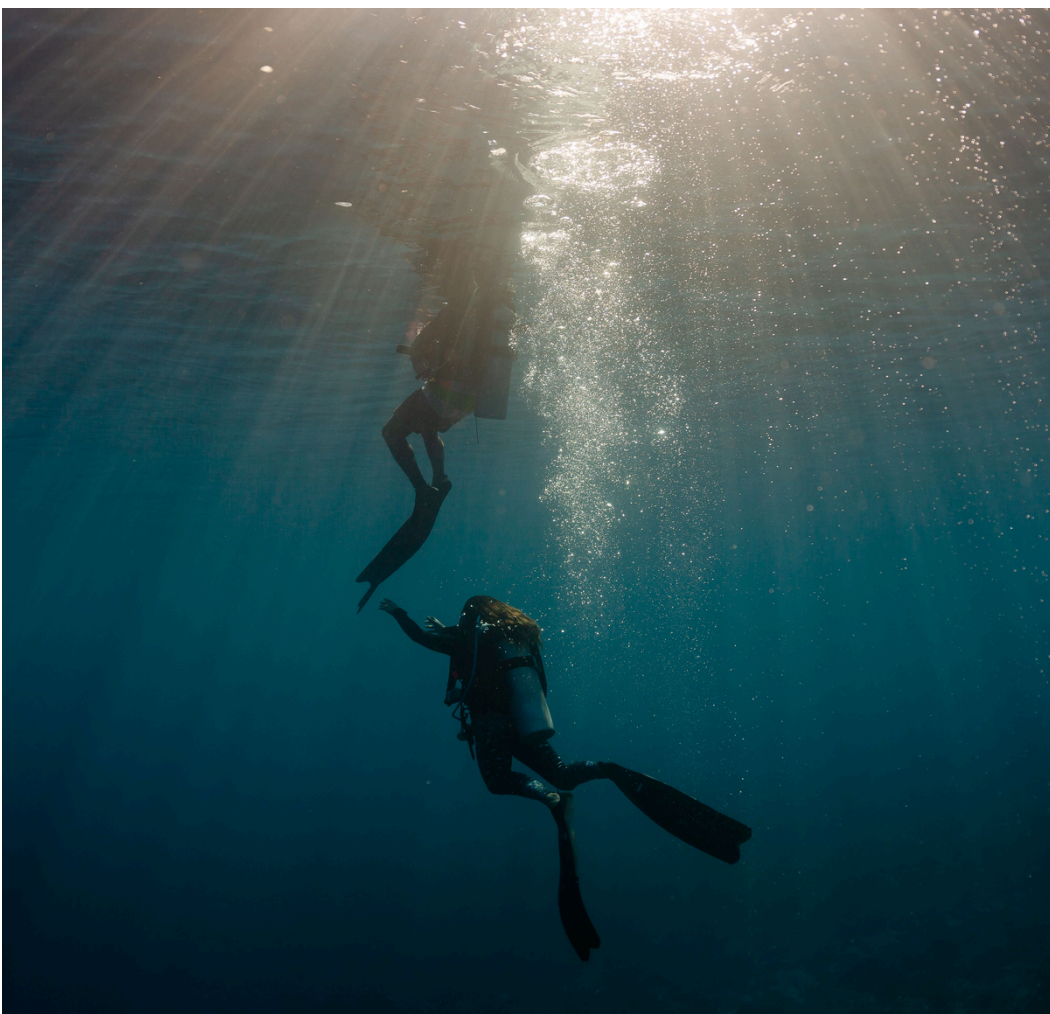
Diver Options:

- **GOLDEN PASSAGE:** A drift dive through a fast-moving channel, home to turtles, sweetlips, and trevallies.
- **CRYSTAL ROCK:** A pinnacle dive featuring reef sharks, grey sharks, and abundant marine life.
- **CASTLE ROCK:** A technical dive in strong currents, with schooling jacks, reef sharks, fusiliers, and vibrant corals.
- **NIGHT DIVE (Optional) – Pagoda:** A macro dive revealing Komodo's nocturnal marine life.

Diver Options:

- **KARANG MAKASSAR:** A manta ray hotspot, where these majestic creatures gather in shallow waters (8-15m).
- **BATU BOLONG:** A pinnacle dive featuring colorful corals, reef fish, blacktip and whitetip sharks, trevally, barracudas, and dogtooth tunas.
- **TATAWA BESAR:** A drift dive over healthy coral reefs, teeming with fusiliers, reef fish, and soft coral formations.
- **TATAWA KECIL (Optional, Advanced):** A dive with boulders, caverns, sea fans, and large schools of snappers, sweetlips, and jacks.





DAY 06

PULAU GILI LAWA

The day begins with an optional early morning trek in the savannah of Gili Lawa, offering panoramic views of the surrounding islands. After breakfast onboard, guests prepare for a day of spectacular diving in Komodo's northern waters.

The first dive takes place at The Cauldron (Shotgun Passage), a thrilling site where strong currents create a unique underwater topography, stunning coral gardens, and encounters with manta rays, eagle rays, and pelagic fish. This is followed by a dive at Aquarium, an easy and scenic coral garden dive with the possibility of spotting manta rays and passing pelagics.

The final dive of the day is at Golden Passage (Reverse Way), offering another drift dive through a vibrant coral-filled channel.

Diver Option:

- **THE CAULDRON (Shotgun Passage):** A dynamic passage dive with strong currents, eagle rays, mantas, and pelagic species.
- **AQUARIUM:** A relaxed coral garden dive, home to healthy reefs, mantas, and passing pelagic fish.
- **GOLDEN PASSAGE (Reverse Way):** A drift dive through stunning coral gardens, teeming with marine life and fast-moving currents.



DAY 07

KOMODO CENTRAL

An early morning departure towards Komodo Central, where guests will enjoy their final dives at Pulau Siaba before sailing back to Labuan Bajo.

On the journey back, guests will have time to fill in and stamp their dive logbooks, exchange photos and memories, and enjoy a farewell ceremony with the Jakare crew.

Diver Option:

- **SIABA BESAR:** A calm bay dive with healthy coral reefs, turtles, stingrays, and excellent macro life.
- **SIABA KECIL (Advanced Drift Dive):** A fast-moving drift dive with rich hard corals, sea fans, and pelagic life such as trevallies and sharks.
