DAY 01

SORONG TO YANBUBA

Guests will be picked up from Sorong airport or their hotel and board Jakare at the Sorong Harbour. After settling into their cabins, the Jakare will sail 40NM toward North Raja Pulau Waigeo.

During the sail, guests can rest and receive activity briefings, including equipment checks for snorkeling and diving. Depending on arrival time, there may be an opportunity to visit a village or snorkel at the jetty. Divers may also have a check-dive. Overnight anchorage in the calm Yanbuba Bay.

DAY 02

PULAU MANSUAR

Discover the beautiful beach and village, snorkelling and check dive at Yanbuba if not already done Snorkel and dive nearby Kri Island Cape Kri and then sail to nearby Saunderek (Pulau Mansuar).

Snorkel and dive Saunderek Jetty and discover the village / beach. Overnight sail to Pulau Wayag.





DAY 03

PULAU WAYAG

Arriving at dawn in Wayag offers stunning light and scenery. Guests can start the day with a trek up Mont Pindito for breathtaking views of the limestone islands. The rest of the day is spent exploring Wayag's inner lagoon, pristine beaches, and snorkeling spots filled with giant clams and vibrant marine life.

Divers will enjoy sites like Batu Seven and a secret spot featuring mantas and coral gardens. Overnight mooring or anchoring in the calm inner lagoon.



DAY 04

PULAU KAWE

In the morning, sail to Pulau Kawe (approx. 14 NM) with a possible stop at Wayag Rangers station to spot black tip sharks. Jakare then sails southward, crossing the equator before reaching Kawe's snorkeling and dive spots, Black Rock and Eagle Rock.

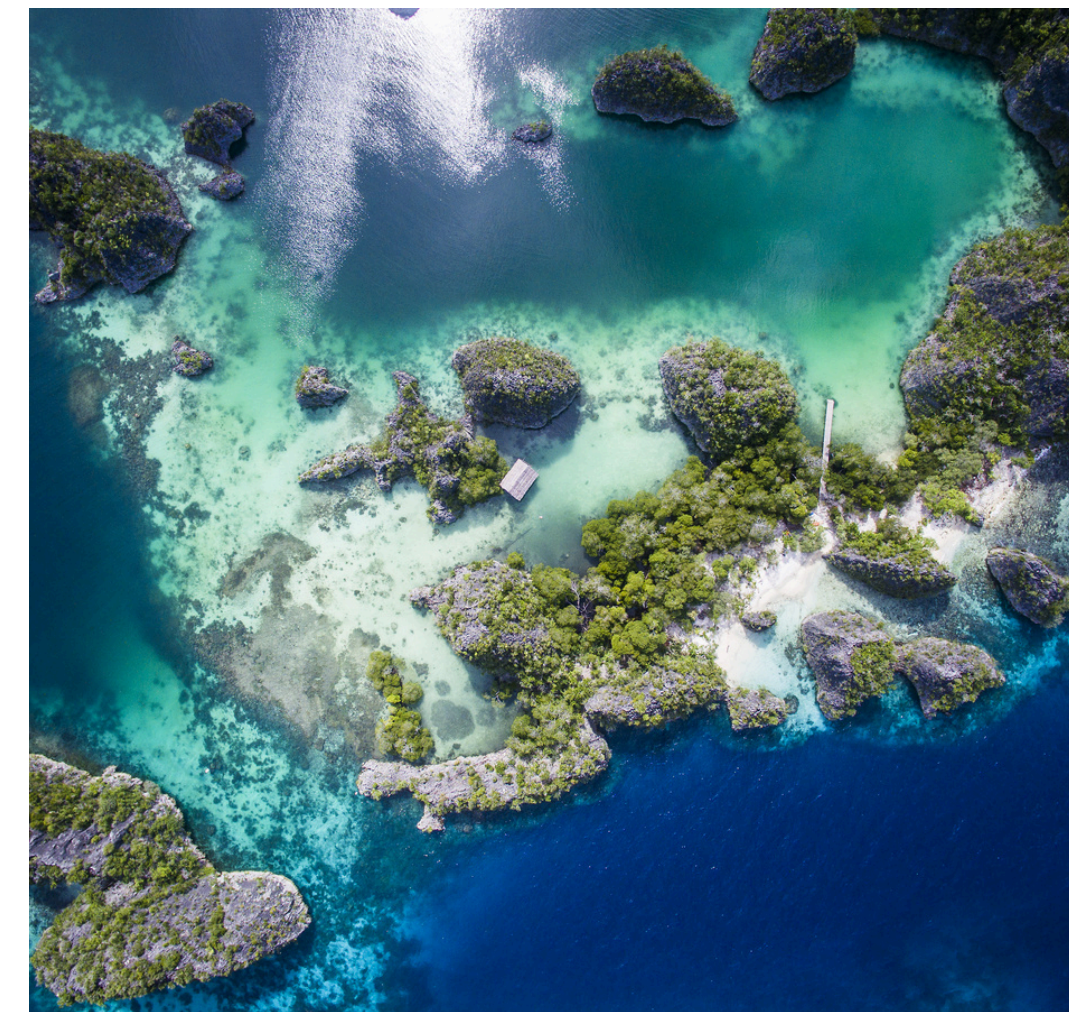
Both spots are known for strong currents, with Black Rock featuring soft coral gardens, sharks, and Napoleon fish, while Eagle Rock offers mantas at cleaning stations and wobbegong sharks among colorful corals. After diving, Jakare sails to Aljui Bay for a quiet mooring near the Pearl Farm, with an optional night dive at the Farm Jetty.

DAY 05

PULAU WOFOH

In the morning, guests can visit the pearl farm. Jakare then sails 6 NM to Pulau Wooh, a paradise with pristine beaches to explore via kayak or paddle.

Snorkeling reveals vibrant coral gardens, while divers can enjoy a stunning wall and sandy valley with schools of trevallies, fusiliers, and turtles. In the afternoon, Jakare heads 8 NM southwest to anchor at Pulau Maniafun.



DAY 06

PULAU PIENEMU

Jakare departs early while guests sleep, with breakfast served en route to Pienemu. Upon arrival, the first snorkel and dive of the day takes place at Keruo Channel, a drift site with stunning coral walls, reef fish, barracudas, and snappers. Afterward, guests can snorkel or dive at Melissa Garden, featuring coral-covered pinnacles and schools of fusiliers, jacks, and trevallies.

Non-divers can enjoy nearby beaches and snorkeling. After lunch, Jakare moves north for a trek up a limestone mount for panoramic views of Pienemu, followed by a swim in the lagoon. The day ends with a night dive at Pulau Yangello (12 NM), where peaceful mangroves await exploration.





DAY 07

PULAU ARBONEK

Wake up to the sound of white cockatoos and explore the inner mangroves of Pulau Yangello by kayak, or opt for an early dive. Breakfast is served en route to Pulau Arborek, where Jakare anchors in front of the island. Arborek offers snorkeling, diving, beach walks, and village visits.

The jetty is an easy dive spot with vibrant coral gardens and giant clams. After exploring Arborek, Jakare sails to Manta Sandy (1 NM) for snorkeling and diving at the Manta Cleaning station. Later, sail east to Pulau Friwen (13 NM), enjoy the sunset, and anchor for the night.

DAY 08

PULAU MIOSKON

Activities around Pulau Mioskon include snorkeling, diving, and exploring from dinghies. Mioskon Reef is a vibrant spot, home to yellow snappers, Napoleon wrasse, trevallies, wobbegong sharks, and pygmy seahorses.

Blue Magic offers thrilling current dives with reef fish, pelagics, and mantas. Afterward, Jakare sails back to Friwen anchorage for swimming, snorkeling, beach relaxation, and village exploration.



DAY 09

FRIWEN

Early morning trek to spot the Bird of Paradise, a rare species in West Papua, followed by breakfast. Enjoy snorkeling and diving at Friwen Wall, then relax on the beach or kayak. The day ends with a beach BBQ and party.

DAY 10

BACK TO SORONG

The final day is for the return journey to Sorong. Guests can log their dives, share memories, and participate in a farewell ceremony before departing for the airport or hotel.
