

DISCOVER THE MAJESTIC DEPTHS OF RAJA AMPAT

Raja Ampat is a diver's paradise and one of the world's most renowned diving destinations. Known for it's kaleidoscopic coral reefs, dramatic underwater pinnacles, and an unparalleled array of marine biodiversity.

The highlight for many is the chance to explore untouched dive sites teeming with vibrant marine life, from playful manta rays to elusive pygmy seahorses, in one of the richest ecosystems on Earth.

Above the water, Raja Ampat boasts emerald-green atolls, towering limestone karsts, and turquoise lagoons.

With secluded beaches and lush mangroves, it's a natural masterpiece offering breathtaking views and a serene escape.



DAY ONE

Upon arrival in Sorong, guests will be greeted by our team and transferred to the harbor, just 15 minutes away, to board Scubaspa ZEN Indonesia.

After settling in and relaxing, we'll set sail toward our first destination. In the evening, the spa team will assist with treatment bookings, and the Cruise Managers will introduce the crew and provide a boat briefing.

The day ends with a welcome dinner on the top deck, accompanied by a stunning sunset over central Raja Ampat.





DAY TWO

Wake up to the serene beauty of Central Raja Ampat's tranquil islands, nestled in the renowned Dampier Strait region. Our first full day of diving begins here, with three spectacular dives exploring vibrant hard coral gardens teeming with aquarium-like marine life, graceful turtles, the fascinating wobbegongs, and the possibility of encounters with passing pelagic species.

As the day concludes, embark on an exciting night dive along the critter-filled sandy slopes near Tapokren village. For early risers, there's an opportunity to hike and witness the mesmerizing display of the endemic Red Birds of Paradise—a truly magical start to the day



DAY FOUR

Marking midway through the expedition, we remain on the western edge of central Raja Ampat to truly explore the islands of Fam both below and above, visiting the famous viewpoint of Piaynemo with its karst limestone cliffs, and Melissa's Garden, arguably the most beautiful and pristine coral garden in all of Raja Ampat.

Our afternoon and evening will be spent with a sunset sail heading south towards some of the most stunning and vibrant soft corals in the world – Misool.

DAY THREE

This day centers on the search for megafauna, with dives at manta cleaning stations offering a chance to witness these graceful giants cleaning and feeding above the reef.

While sightings can never be guaranteed, mantas are known to frequent the sandy-bottom coral patches in this area regularly, making the chances of encountering these incredible creatures quite high.

Other highlights may include the fish-filled Mayhem dive site, aptly named for the constant chaos of marine life swirling through its waters.





DAY FIVE

Arriving early in the morning at the eastern edge of Misool, in the remote and rarely visited Daram Islands, you'll likely have the entire area to yourself. The dramatic underwater landscapes and thriving marine life, including frequent manta encounters and dense schools of shimmering fish, create an unforgettable diving experience. Sometimes, the fish are so abundant it's hard to spot your dive buddy through the silver swirl of silversides.




DAY SIX

The central Misool area is full of world-famous dive sites and we will be exploring as many of as possible.

Highlights include Nudi Rock, a dive site full of soft coral-covered walls that gets its name from the above-water shape of the island.

Boo Window, which not only has a high chance of pelagic encounters but also an incredible shallow swim-through filled with fish and Magic Mountain, maybe the most famous of all, for its regular encounters with mantas and huge groups of oceanic fish species, barracudas, groupers, trevallies, and sharks.





DAY SEVEN

On our final day of diving, the excitement continues with two spectacular morning dives in the Misool area. These last dives offer a final chance to encounter larger fish and marvel at the vibrant colors of the reef before lunch. While the incredible diving comes to an end, the afternoon holds activities for everyone as we make our way back to Sorong Harbor.

Relax with a soothing massage from our professional therapists, or for the adventurous, take a dip in a stingless jellyfish lake—an extraordinary experience found in only a handful of places worldwide.
