# UNCOVER TRITON BAY: INDONESIA'S HIDDEN PARADISE

Nestled in West Papua's Kaimana Marine Protected Area, Triton Bay is Indonesia's ultimate diving frontier.

Since its first exploration in 2006, new dive sites continue to emerge, preserving the bay's allure as a pristine time capsule filled with vibrant soft corals and unique underwater habitats—remote, untouched, and ready to be explored.

Celebrated by divers and marine biologists alike, Triton Bay has earned names like "The Fish Empire," "City of Dusk," and "The Lost Paradise."

Researchers have documented 937 species of marine fish here, including rare species found only in this region, alongside 492 types of coral, six of which are unique to Triton Bay.



#### **DAY ONE**

After being greeted at the airport or hotel by Scubaspa ZEN crew, travel to the harbor and embark Scubaspa ZEN.

Enjoy a short rest before unpacking while the spa opens to offer information and treatment reservations.

Crew introductions and boat briefings will be held by the Cruise Managers followed by a welcome dinner at our al fresco restaurant.





#### **DAY TWO, THREE & FOUR**

These days are dedicated to enjoying the dives in Triton Bay, one of the world's most biodiverse marine havens.

Explore stunning soft corals, towering sea fans, and mysterious black coral forests teeming with over 959 fish species and 471 coral types.

Highlights include vibrant sweetlips, colorful macro life, and a chance to swim with whale sharks at the Bagan fishing platforms. Triton Bay's rich marine life and vibrant sponges make it a paradise for divers of all levels.



#### **DAY FIVE**

Our next destination will be either Fak-Fak or the sheltered haven of Papisoi, depending on the weather.


Fak-Fak offers a breathtaking waterfall experience accessible by tender, where, if the swells are calm, you can even enjoy a refreshing swim.

The water near the falls is cool, and adventurous guests can slip around the left side to discover a hidden cave, offering a perfect vantage point to admire the waterfall without getting wet.

#### **DAY SIX**

The beautiful Pisang Island archipelago offers an unforgettable dive experience, where lively coral reefs teem with diverse marine life.


Keep an eye out for T-Bone, the Hammerhead, as you explore vibrant underwater landscapes. To the north, discover secluded beaches and largely unexplored patch reefs, adding a touch of adventure to this hidden paradise.



#### **DAY SEVEN & EIGHT**

These days are dedicated to bringing you to Misool in southern Raja Ampat, where vibrant reefs, black mantas, and walking sharks await.

Highlights include Daram's colorful sites, Fiabacet's rich marine life, Wayil Batan's strong currents, and Pelee Island's majestic corals and swim-throughs—an unforgettable dive experience.





#### **DAY NINE**

Explore the thriving strait between Waigeo and Batanta, a rising star in Raja Ampat's dive scene. Thanks to nutrient-rich currents, this area offers a breathtaking underwater paradise with diverse marine life at every turn.

Beyond the colorful corals and swarming fish, watch for rare gems like the elusive Pontohi pygmy seahorse. Each dive here promises unique encounters and the thrill of discovery, making it a must-visit for passionate divers.



#### **DAY TEN**

This area is teeming with marine life flourishing among vibrant coral reefs. Wobbegong sharks are frequently seen, especially around Mioskon.

Blue Magic, a submerged seamount, offers encounters with majestic Giant manta rays. Sardine Reef, though lacking sardines, bursts with fusiliers, surgeonfish, trevallies, and more, set against a backdrop of sea fans, soft corals, and elephant ear sponges—a lively scene filled with the energy of fish darting through the water.

#### **DAY ELEVEN**

After breakfast and the last exchange of photos and memories, the crew and Scubaspa ZEN will say our fondest farewells and transport you either to your hotel or the airport.
