For eight months of the year (April to November), the southeast trade winds whip up the seas and bring cool, nutrient-rich waters from the Indian Ocean, creating exciting diving conditions. The water might be cooler and the visibility limited, but divers get rewarded with a unique and exhilarating experience.

As the seasons turn and the northwest trade winds take over (from December to March), the conditions transform dramatically. While North Komodo becomes less inviting, South Komodo emerges as the prime destination. The water turns calm, warm, and crystal clear, unveiling previously inaccessible underwater wonders.

Despite being the wet season in Indonesia, the towering mountains of Flores and Sumbawa catch most of the rainfall, leaving Komodo relatively dry, especially in the south. This hidden gem offers unparalleled diving adventures during these months.

So, pack your gear and delve into otherwise inaccessible locations, where vibrant soft corals adorn rocky reefs, and an abundance of marine life awaits your exploration.



The Seven Seas crew will pick you up in the morning at the Airport in Labuan Bajo or your hotel in town. Your adventure begins with a check dive in the enchanting southeast waters of Rinca Island.

This time of the year usually brings calm seas to the region, resulting in the waters around Rinca Island remaining clear, providing good visibility and making night diving more enjoyable.

Exploring the dive sites in Horse Shoe Bay is an unforgettable adventure, typically requiring 5 to 7 days for a truly comprehensive experience. On this day, be prepared for four exhilarating dives that promise to captivate and thrill.

It's time to explore **Cannibal Rock**, where a vibrant tapestry of soft corals, sea apples, and anemones creates a kaleidoscope of colors. Feel the adrenaline as you descend the dramatic **Yellow Wall**, surrounded by a stunning array of soft yellow corals, sponges, and crinoids. For macro photography enthusiasts, **Crynold Canyon** is a dream come true, offering the chance to see pygmy seahorses, ornate ghost pipefish, and a variety of shrimp species.

End your day at **Torpedo Point**, where the diverse terrain of sandy slopes, coral bommies, and rocky outcrops promises thrilling encounters. Keep an eye out for torpedo rays, known for their ability to deliver electric shocks, adding an element of excitement to your dive.



Delve further into the dive sites of **Horse Shoe Bay** and prepare for four more thrilling dives at Boulders, Eagle Rock, and Gigi Rusak in Padar Island. Here, you'll encounter the exhilarating diversity of this underwater paradise.

Gigi Rusak dive site offers rich biodiversity and stunning coral formations, appealing to both macro enthusiasts and those seeking encounters with larger marine species. It proves to be a versatile and visually rewarding dive experience. Divers have a chance to witness schools of Mobula Rays, adding to the site's allure.



The day will be dedicated to diving in South Komodo with four unforgettable dives specifically in two renowned sites: **Manta Alley** and **Loh Sera**, each offering distinct and captivating underwater experiences. **Manta Alley** is celebrated for its encounters with manta rays and often features cleaning stations where smaller fish attend to the mantas, removing parasites. Witnessing this symbiotic relationship up close is fascinating and offers insight into the intricacies of marine life.

On the contrary, **Loh Sera** boasts vibrant coral reefs bustling with diverse marine life. From vivid reef fish weaving through the corals to larger inhabitants like reef sharks and turtles, there is a continuous stream of discoveries. Furthermore, Loh Sera is recognized for its opportunities in macro photography, with an array of critters such as nudibranchs, shrimp, and octopuses inhabiting the reef, providing plenty of subjects for underwater photographers to capture. End the day with a night dive and witness the reef as the day comes to an end.

HOW TO GET THERE

All trips in Komodo National Park start and end in the port of **Labuan Bajo** which is on the island of Flores.

There are multiple daily flights from Bali Airport (DPS) (1 hour) and Jakarta Airport (CGK) (2 hours) bring you to Labuan Bajo Airport (LBJ), only a quick 10-minute drive from the port.

On the day of the trip, our crew will meet you at the airport or your accommodation in Labuan Bajo for embarkation.
