During your cruise you will perform a minimum of 42 dives:

- * 1 dive-guide/ 4 divers maximum (4 guides/16 divers)
- * Free nitrox for certified divers (possibility of certification on board)
- * 3 fibreglass tenders
- * Our great crew is at your service to carry your tank and gear



Currents

Halmahera is well known for its consistent currents that can be dangerous. Wallacea dive cruise has a real experience of the scuba diving sites. We pay very much attention to dive at the right place at the right time in order to avoid that uncomfortable and dangerous currents. Obviously before each dive, briefings will inform you about the diving conditions and advises will be given to always keep the dives safe. However, a strong scuba diving experience is required for this fabulous cruise. A reef hook can be useful.



Visibility

Visibility can rapidly change. Commonly you can see 30 meters away, but visibility can diminish in certain areas or punctually.

Temperature

The temperature is all year long between 28° and 30°C. Long wetsuit 3 mm is recommended.





Service



Mixing eastern and western specialties, our chef cuisine is a «fusion" that will never let you hungry.





- 1 Dive the day of departure
- 3 dives / day every day of the cruise
- 8 Night dives.
- 1 dive the day before disembarking, maybe 2 according to your flight schedule (24h/No FLY).

Schedule & standards

• 1st dive: 07:00am

• 2nd dive: 10:30am

• 3rd dive: 02:30pm

• Night dive: 06:30pm

- Dive time: 60 minutes
- Maximum Depth: 35 meters
- Dives into the safety curves
- Systematic safety stop

Due to the large number of dives and the remoteness of the location, we urge divers to stay within no-deco limits, to stay above a maximum depth of 35 meters, and to perform a safety stop at the end of every dive.

Depending on the guests' dive experience, interests (photography, macro, etc), and use of nitrox (free for certified divers), the Cruise Director will arrange the diving

groups. These groups are made up of four divers max and a dive guide. The dive guides are rotated on a daily basis. Each diver is given a dive tank (DIN & INT available, no need for adapters) and their own dive station for the duration of the cruise.

A briefing will be conducted by the Cruise Director or one of the guides before each dive. It will describe the site topography, depths, currents and potential hazards, as well as the marine life we expect to encounter.

The staff carries your tank between the MV Ambai and the dinghies. Onboard the dinghies, tanks are placed in slots and the guide will help you to gear up just before you backroll into the water.

Identification books of flora and local fauna are available on board, and the dive guides or the Cruise Director will always help you identify that strange animal you just found underwater! There is some dive equipment to rent on board: However, all sizes are not necessarily available, so please book it before the cruise.

- * Our cruises are open to divers Padi Advanced Open Water or equivalent with at least 50 dives logged. Less experienced divers can also participate with special supervision that needs to be arranged before the cruise.
- * Insurance covering medical evacuation and diving accidents is highly recommended. Divers will be filling out a statement of medical fitness for dive activities onboard.
- * We expect you to carefully respect and protect the underwater world: have good buoyancy to avoid touching the reef or breaking any corals; do not touch the animals, do not collect anything; do not harass wildlife for photos and moderate the number of flashes you impose on them. The use of gloves is not allowed.
- * Divers should always carry a surface marker buoy.
